Good morning everyone,

I hope you are all well and you had a lovely weekend.

Here is the latest news from BSM:

- Some of our year 6 pupils returned to school on Thursday 4th June and all went really well.
- I had a meeting with the other Transform Heads and executives on Friday. We have been given the go-ahead to propose further expanded provision as all is going smoothly with Year 6.

I have proposed the following:

- To re-open to Year 1 from Thursday 11th June

This remains subject to executive and union agreement, so is purely a target date for now.

I'm hoping to confirm Year 1 as soon as possible.

- Groups, staffing and classrooms for Year One have been finalised, based on confirmed 'returners' – those that said they wanted a place when contacted by phone a couple of weeks ago. For now at least, we cannot accept new admissions. Please contact us urgently if you have changed your mind and you no longer require a place for your child.
- Please remember a child cannot have a keyworker place and a year group place – they are in one bubble of pupils or the other. Year group pupils are not in on a Wednesday, as school is having a thorough clean mid-week every week.
- The above meeting agreed that the expanded provision of Year 6 should continue until Friday 3rd July (rather than the original 26th June) as the return had been delayed by a week.
- It was also agreed that the date of Monday 6th July would be the target date for a return for Year Five.
- Parents/carers of children in Year 5 can now expect to be contacted by the team in the next couple of weeks to confirm whether or not their child would be taking up a place if and when offered.
